

# SecurePay Module for ECWZ ASP Cart v1.x

Thank you for purchasing the SecurePay module v1.x for ECWZ Classic ASP Cart.

SecurePay is an API-based solution provided by surepay.com on credit card processing payment gateway. This add-on module is used to integrate your ECWZ shopping cart with the SecurePay solution. It is an easy installation and can be done within 5 ~ 10 min. For more information about SecurePay's API, visit <http://www.securepay.com>

This documentation contains installation instruction and Operational manual for you to install and operate with the SecurePay module.

Note:

a. In order to use SecurePay module, you need to make sure you have received the SecurePay web payment gateway API package from the SecurePay support team. This package needs to be installed in the server or the SecurePay module will not be able to communicate with the SecurePay payment gateway server.

b. If "Return\_Code" is "N" then the "Approv\_Num" will equal "Not-Approved", the "Card\_Response" field will contain more verbose information that may not be appropriate for the customer to see. Terms like "CALL AUTH CENTER", "PICK UP CARD" or other wording that explains why the transaction resulted in a Decline. This information is informative and should be captured but may better be suited for the merchant and not the customer. If the "Return\_Code" is "N" you may want to give the customer an opportunity to pay with another card or by another method.

## Installation Instruction:

### 1. Unzip the SecurePay v1.x.zip and upload the unzipped files to the web server.

After you have downloaded the SecurePay v1.x.zip file from ECWZ.net, you will need to unzip this set of file into your local hard-drive. Here are the folder lists after the decompression of the zip file:

- a. /admin
- b. /store

Upload all the contents to the root of your site using any protocol you want (we recommend FTP protocol here). If you plan to put your store under your domain

<http://www.mystore.com>, then you must upload all the files into the web root folder of mystore.com.

Note: If you have purchased any of the skin template set, then the skin template set should include the skin files for this module already. If your skin file set does not include files for this module, contact us at ECWZ.NET and we will email you a set of the files for the skins you have purchased.

## **2. Executing the sql.txt file to install the module into your store.**

After uploading files into your web root, you need to execute the SQL statements in the sql.txt file in order to install the modules into your online store. You can use any text editor to open the SQL.txt file and execute those statements with any kind of database management tool. Keep in mind that some DB Management tool might have problem executing the "GO" keyword. If that's the case, you might have to execute these statements one by one.

## **3. Recreate your language profile.**

After you run the SQL statements, there will be new entries for the language text stored into your textlayertbl table. In order for your online store to load these new languages text, you will need to log into the back-end admin of your store -> Store Configuration -> Edit Language -> and click on the Process button to recreate the text layer file (Feel free to edit the text information for this module).

## **4. Back-end Configuration for SecurePay module.**

### **4-1. module\_securepay.asp**

**a. Payment Status:** This setting is the config to enable/disable this paypal web payment pro credit card processing method.

**b. Merchant Account ID:** This ID is assigned by the SecurePay payment gateway company. If you do not know your merchant account ID with SecurePay, please contact the SecurePay's support team.

**c. Charge Mode:** This setting is for store owner to choose either to charge customer at the end of the online purchase (if it is set to "Online") or to charge customer before shipping the items to customer at the order management under administration area (if it is set to Offline)..

**e. Transaction Type:** The 2 types of transaction being processed:

SALE- Indicates a charge to be placed against a credit card account.

PREAUTH- Indicates a pre-authorization on a Credit Card. This is a temporary block on an Amount submitted by the Merchant. This is not a qualified transaction and if not closed with a FORCE transaction it will release the block after 5-7 days depending on the card issuer. This can have a negative impact on the funds availability of the card holder and should be used appropriately.

**f. Email Customer:** Set this control to Yes if you wish securepay.com to send customer an email after any charges. Leave it as No if you do not wish customer to get any emails from securepay.com upon any charges.
